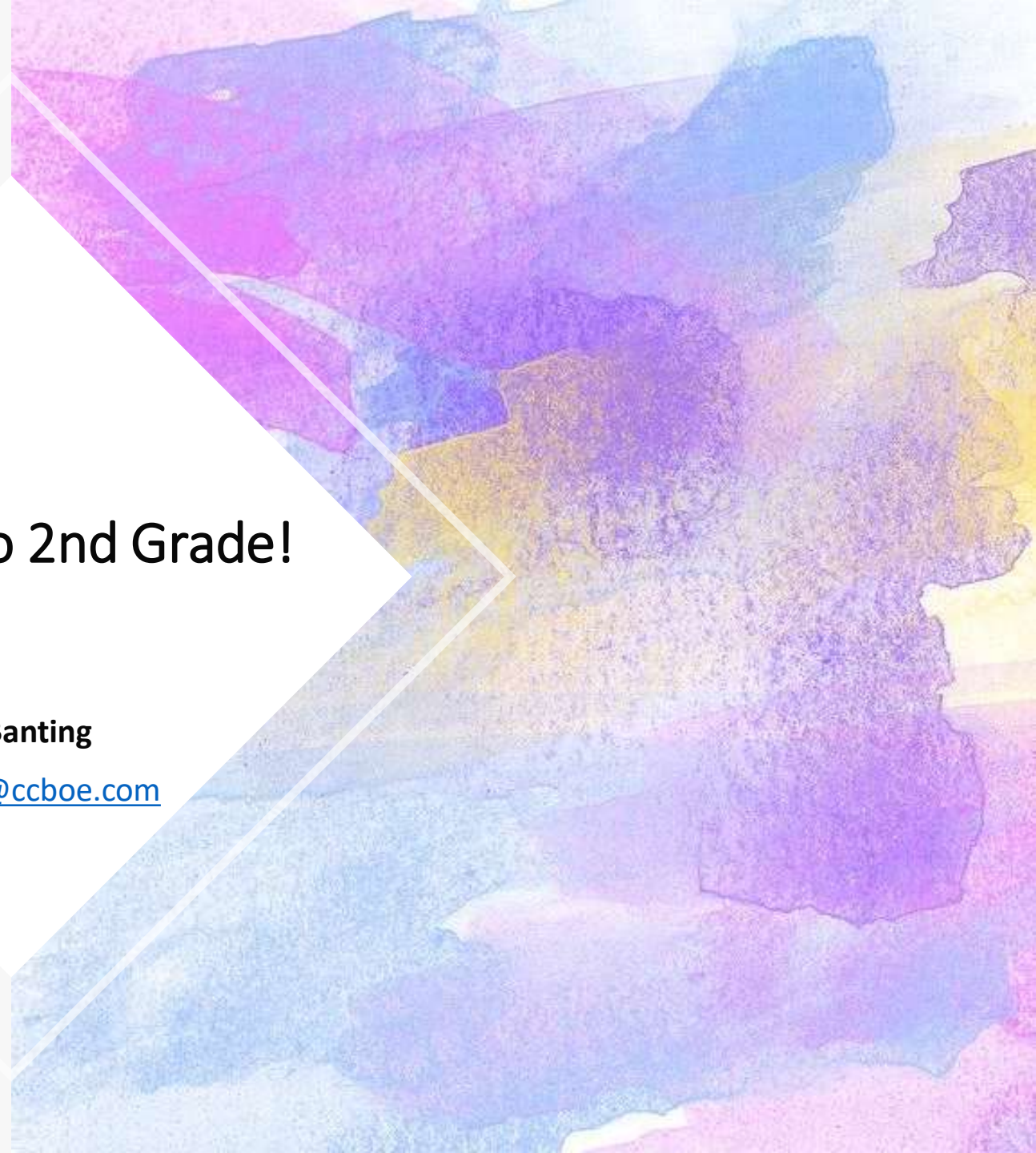

- **Students have been taking i-Ready assessments in reading and math. This will help teachers in planning lessons and small group instruction with students.**
- **Once per quarter, teachers will conduct a Running Record to test for the current reading level.**
