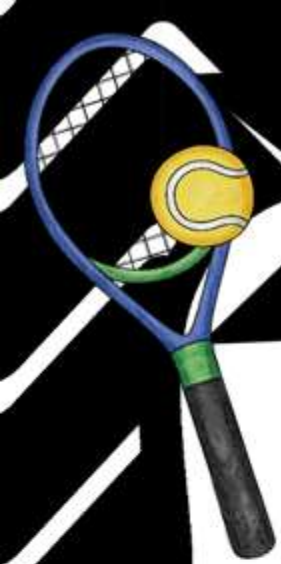


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# School Policy

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# GRADING POLICY

Grades will be put in Synergy every two weeks.

Grading scale:

A = 90-100%

B = 80-89%

C = 70-79%

D = 60-69%

F = 0-59%\*

**Process: 50%** - Warm ups, exit slips, student performance during learning activity, math problem solving, reading participation- answering questions

**Product: 50%**- Tests, quizzes, reports, projects, class assessments

Read for 15 minutes per night  
Play a math game or do Dream Box

*It is highly recommended that 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades practice the multiplication and division facts a couple of times per week.*



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# READING

We will be using reading rotations for whole group and guided reading.

Whole group is grade leveled texts.

Guided reading is instructional leveled texts.

Students will have their own books in class to read during whole group and guided reading.

Students are taught the state reading standards.



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# LANGUAGE ARTS

Writing will be done within the reading curriculum. Students are expected to be able to write complete sentences with correct capitalization and punctuation. **Please practice these concepts at home.** Older students should be writing paragraphs when doing their work. Students are also expected to use legible writing so words can be understood.



# MATH

Math will be done in math rotations.

Students will have access to manipulatives in class:  
Manipulatives- place value blocks, other blocks, hundreds chart, number line, counters (younger grades), addition and multiplication charts, etc.

- Calculator for upper grades (per IEP) and as teacher directs

Students are taught the state math standards.

Science is taught by Ms. Daniel for 2<sup>nd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade.

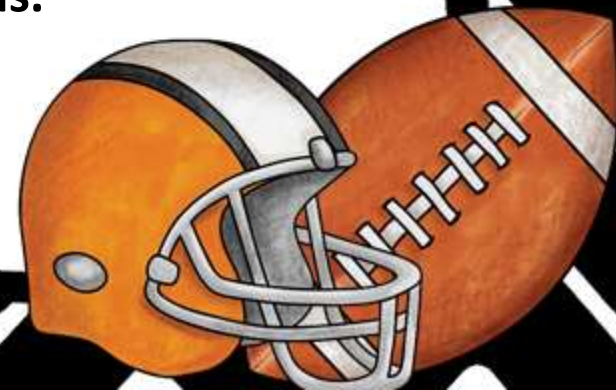
